Family Crisis Intervention Unit (FCIU)

24 hour/day, 7-day/week crisis intervention services to Warren County families. The Unit provides an immediate response to stabilize a family crisis situation.

FCIU provides the following services:

- Crisis intervention
- Assessment
- Short term individual and family therapy
- Referrals for long-term treatment
- Temporary out-of-home placement
- Access to Family Court

The FCIU is mandated by the State to intervene and work with juveniles and their families when there is:

- A serious threat to the well-being and physical safety of a juvenile, or
- A serious conflict between a parent/guardian and a juvenile, or
- Runaway behavior, or
- Truancy

A referral can be made by law enforcement, schools, parents/guardians, and concerned others.

- The victim must have reported the crime to police within 9 months
- The victim must cooperate with reasonable request of the investigation and prosecution of the crime
- The claim must be filed within 5 years of the date of the crime
