30 days incarceration in Morris County Detention Center;

30 days will be suspended

days credit for time previously served

100 hours of community service,

Pay:

\$ 60 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty,

\$ 15 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty;

Restitution to victim in an amount of \$1568.47.

Provide a DNA sample;

Undergo fingerprinting,

Undergo a mental health evaluation and complete any recommended treatment,

Obtain and maintain part time employment when in school,

Letter of apology to Victim


Other: Tour of Morris County Detention Center, No contact with co-jvenile.
