On April 28th, 2010, Jackie Altobelli, 30, residing at 114 Main Street, Hackettstown, NJ and Nicole Hoernlen, 29, residing at 178 Alexandria Drive, Hackettstown, NJ were arrested after a six week long narcotics investigation conducted by the Hackettstown Police Department, Warren County Prosecutor's Office-Narcotics Task Force, Independence Township Police Department and the New Jersey State Police.

Jackie Altobelli is charged with:

1. Two (2) counts of possession with intent to distribute heroin, a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and 2C:35-5b(3).
2. One (1) count of distribution of heroin, a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and 2C:35-5b(3).
3. Two (2) counts of unlawful possession of heroin, third degree offenses in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1)
4. One (1) count of hindering apprehension, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-3b(1)
5. One (1) count of possession of drug paraphernalia, a disorderly persons offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-2
6. One (1) count of possession of hypodermic needle, a disorderly persons offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:36-6

Nicole Hoernlen is charged with:

1. One (1) count of failure to make lawful disposition, a disorderly persons offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2:35-10c.

Each third degree crime carries a maximum penalty of up to five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison. Each fourth degree crime carries a maximum penalty of up to eighteen (18) months in New Jersey State Prison. Each disorderly

persons offense carries a maximum penalty of six (6) months in the Warren County Correctional Center.

The charges carry the following possible fines:

1. each third degree charges for distribution and possession with intent to distribute heroin carries a maximum penalty of \$75,000 for each offense
2. each third degree charge for unlawful possession of a controlled dangerous substance carries a maximum penalty of \$35,000
3. each disorderly persons offense carries a maximum penalty of \$1,000

Jackie Altobelli was lodged in the Warren County Correctional Center in default of \$40,000.00 bail without a 10% option. First appearance before Warren County Superior Court Judge John J. Coyle, Jr. was held on Thursday, April, 29th, 2010 at Warren County Superior Court, Belvidere NJ.

Nicole Hoernlen was processed and released pending a future Court date.

Please be advised that all defendants are presumed innocent of all charges unless and until proven guilty.
