The above-named individual was arrested in White Township, NJ on September 30, 2010 by the New Jersey State Police. The investigation was conducted by DSgt. Toni Latario of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit and Detective Eric Clowes of the New Jersey State police.

The defendant was charged with three counts of Second degree Sexual Assault, One count of Second Degree Endangering the Welfare of a Child, One count of Third degree Possession of a Firearm by a Certain Person Not to Have Possession of a Weapon and two counts of Fourth degree Criminal Sexual Contact.

The Second degree Crimes carry a maximum term of imprisonment of up to ten (10) years in New Jersey State Prison. The third degree crime carries a maximum term of up to five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison and the Fourth degree crimes carry a maximum term of imprisonment of up to 18 months in New Jersey State prison.

The complaint alleges that on September 26, 2010, the defendant sexually assaulted the victim by committing acts of sexual penetration upon a victim who is at least 16 years of age but less than 18. The defendant was acquainted with the victim.

The defendant was arrested and transported by the New Jersey State police to the Warren County Correctional Facility. Bail was set at \$150,000 without ten (10%) percent option with a condition that he not have contact with the victim, the victim's family, or anyone under the age of eighteen (18), by the Honorable Kimarie Rahill, Judge of the Superior Court. The defendant had his first appearance on Friday, October 1, 2010 at 9:00 AM in the Superior Court, Belvidere, New Jersey.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and the defendant is presumed to be innocent of all charges unless and until proven guilty.
