The above-named individuals were arrested March 7, 2008, in Knowlton Township, Warren County, New Jersey, following an investigation by the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Task Force at the Truckstops of America.


Jones and Williams were both charged with one (1) count of Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance, Crack Cocaine, in the amount of more than one half ounce but less than five ounces, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1)/2C:35-5b(2), a crime of the second degree; one (1) count of Conspiracy to Possess with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance, Crack Cocaine, in the amount of more than one half ounce but less than five ounces, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2/2C:35-5a(1)/2C:35-5b(2), a crime of the second degree; and one (1) count of Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, Crack Cocaine, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), a crime of the third degree. Jones was also charged with one (1) count of Possession of Less than 50 grams of Marijuana, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(4), a disorderly persons offense.

The maximum sentence for each second degree crime is up to ten (10) years New Jersey State Prison and a fine of \$150,000.00. The maximum sentence for the third degree crime is up to five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison and a fine of \$35,000.00. The maximum

sentence for each disorderly persons offense is up to six (6) months in jail and a fine of \$1,000.00.

Bail for both Jones and Williams was set by John J. Coyle, Jr., J.S.C., in the amount of \$100,000.00 full surety. Both individuals were incarcerated in the Warren County Correctional Center in lieu of bail. Both individuals are scheduled for first appearance on Monday, March 10, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. before Judge Pursel.

Please be advised that the defendants are presumed innocent of all charges unless and until proven guilty.
