PRESS RELEASE

Hackettstown, NJ

The above-named individual was arrested Friday, January 22, 2010, on two counts of Sexual Assault (2C:14-2(C) (4) and two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (2C:24-4(A)). Sexual Assault is a second-degree crime and Endangering the Welfare of a Child is a third-degree crime. The second-degree charges carry a maximum term of imprisonment of up to ten (10) years in New Jersey State Prison. The third-degree charge carries a maximum of five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison.

The first complaint alleges that between 7/1/09 - 7/31/09, the defendant sexually assaulted the victim by committing acts of sexual penetration upon the victim, who is less than sixteen years of age and the defendant at the time was more than four years older than the victim. The sexual assault allegedly occurred in Hackettstown, NJ.


The second complaint alleges that on diverse dates between 12/1/09 -1/1/10, the defendant sexually assaulted the victim by committing acts of sexual penetration upon the victim, who is less than sixteen years of age and at the time the defendant was more than four years older than the victim. The sexual assaults took place in Independence Township, NJ. The victim was known to the defendant.

Bail was set by the Honorable Judge John Coyle, J.S.C., at \$50,000.00, with a no ten percent option. The defendant's bail also includes conditions that he not have contact with the victim or her family and no contact with anyone under the age of eighteen. The defendant's first appearance is scheduled for Monday, January 25, 2010 at 1:30 p.m., before the Honorable Judge John Coyle, J.S.C.

Detective Sergeant Toni Latario of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office and Independence Township Chief Dennis Riley conducted the investigation.

The arrest was made by DSgt. Toni Latario and Detective Hernani Goncalves both of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit. Police Officer Darren Tynan of the Hackettstown police Department assisted in the arrest as well.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and that the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven guilty.
