The above-named individual was arrested on January 27, 2010. The investigation was conducted by Detective Derek Kries of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit. The defendant was charged one count of Third Degree Perjury, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-1A. The third degree crimes carry a maximum term of up to five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison.

The charges allege that Morris made a material statement under during an official proceeding which he did not believe to be true.

On December 17, 2008 Morris was indicted by the Warren County Grand Jury on thirty-eight charges including Aggravated Sexual Assault, (First Degree)(one count), Sexual Assault (Second Degree)(one count), Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Second Degree)(eleven counts), Aggravated Assault (Third Degree)(four counts), Terroristic Threats (Third Degree)(two counts), Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose

(Third Degree)(two counts), Aggravated Criminal Sexual Contact (Third Degree)(four counts), Unlawful Possession of a Weapon (Fourth Degree)(two counts), Criminal Sexual Contact (Fourth Degree)(two counts) and Child Cruelty (Fourth Degree)(nine counts).

The Honorable Amy O'Connor, J.S.C., set bail at \$20,000.00 without the ten percent option. His first appearance is scheduled for Friday, January 29, 2009 at 12:15 p.m. before the Hon. Amy O'Connor.

Be advised that the charges are merely accusations and the defendant is presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
