The above-named individual was arrested today, February 20, 2008, by Detective Scott Imboden of the Phillipsburg Police Department and Detective Melissa Viscomi of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Sexual Assault/Child Abuse Unit on the following charges: four counts of Sexual Assault, 2C:14-2(c)4, a crime of the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, Criminal Sexual Contact, four counts of 2C:14-3b, a crime of the 4<sup>th</sup> degree, and Endangering the Welfare of a Child, 2C:24-4a, a crime of the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree.

A 2<sup>nd</sup> degree crime carries a maximum term of imprisonment of up to 10 years in New Jersey State Prison. A 3<sup>rd</sup> degree crime carries a maximum term of imprisonment of up to 5 years in New Jersey State Prison. A fourth-degree crime carries a maximum term of up to 18 months in New Jersey State Prison.

The complaint alleges that between June 1, 2005 and June 30, 2007 the defendant had engaged in a sexual relationship with a female who was between the ages of thirteen and sixteen. The victim was known to the defendant.

Bail was set by the Honorable John H. Pursel, J.S.C. at \$100,000.00 no ten percent. The defendant is being lodged at Warren County Correctional Center. His first appearance is scheduled for Thursday, February 21, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. before Honorable John H. Pursel, J.S.C. in Belvidere.

Detective Scott Imboden of the Phillipsburg Police Department and Detective Melissa Viscomi of the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Sexual Assault/Child Abuse Unit conducted the investigation.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and that the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven guilty.
