The above named defendant was convicted and sentenced today by Warren County Superior Court Judge John H. Pursel of:

1 Count of Aggravated Assault – 2nd degree

The above conviction involved an unprovoked attack on a juvenile victim at a Hackettstown High School football game on September 14, 2007. Sogluizzo repeatedly punched and kicked his victim in the face and shattered his eye socket, requiring extensive emergency surgery to repair the damage.

Although the crime was committed when the defendant was a juvenile, because of the seriousness of the offense, the case was referred to adult criminal court.

Assistant Prosecutor Dit Mosco handled the case on behalf of the State. The defendant was represented by Christine Finnegan, Esq. The parents and grandparents of the victim were present in court at the time of sentencing. Sogluizzo was sentenced to three years in New Jersey State Prison and must serve 85 percent of his sentence before he is eligible for parole.

The investigation of this matter was conducted by the Hackettstown Police Department.

The above named defendant was convicted and sentenced Friday 13 June 2008 by Warren County Superior Court Judge John H. Pursel of:


- 1 Count of Robbery – 2nd degree
- 1 Count of Aggravated Assault – 3rd degree
- 1 Count of Robbery – 2nd degree

The above convictions involved assaults on and thefts from two separate victims on two separate occasions as well as an aggravated assault on a third victim. The crimes took place over a five month period.

Although one of the robberies was committed when the defendant was a juvenile, because of the seriousness of the offense, the case was referred to adult criminal court.

Assistant Prosecutor Dit Mosco handled the cases on behalf of the State. The defendant was represented by Christine Finnegan, Esq. Hugee was sentenced to four years in New Jersey State Prison on each of the charges and must serve 85 percent of her sentence before she is eligible for parole. The sentences are to be served concurrently.

The investigation of this matter was conducted by the Phillipsburg Police Department.
