On November 30, 2010, Robert Weinert, 31, residing at 173 Augusta Terrace in Easton, Pennsylvania was arrested after a two month long undercover narcotics investigation conducted by the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Narcotic Task Force with the assistance of the Greenwich Township Police Department, the Lopatcong Township Police Department, the Phillipsburg Police Department Special Operations Division, the Washington Township Police Department Special Enforcement Team, and the New Jersey State Police. Defendant was arrested in Greenwich Township following the delivery of one pound of marijuana to another individual

Robert Weinert is charged with one (1) count of distribution of marijuana, a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and 2C:35-5b(11); one (1) count of possession with intent to distribute marijuana, a third degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and 2C:35-5b(11); and one (1) count of unlawful possession of marijuana in a quantity greater than 50 grams, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(3).

Each third degree crime carries a maximum penalty of up to five (5) years in New Jersey State Prison. Each fourth degree crime carries a maximum penalty of up to eighteen (18) months in New Jersey State Prison. Each third degree charge for distribution or possession with intent to distribute marijuana carries a maximum fine of \$25,000. Each fourth degree charge for unlawful possession of marijuana in a quantity greater than 50 grams carries a maximum fine of \$25,000.

Robert Weinert was lodged in the Warren County Correctional Center in default of \$50,000 bail without a 10% option. First appearance before Warren County Superior Court Judge John J. Coyle, Jr. was held Wednesday, December 1, 2010 at the Warren County Courthouse.

Please be advised that the defendant is presumed innocent of all charges unless and until proven guilty.
