
Attend school and obey school rules

Circumstances of the offense:

On 2 October 2009, the juvenile punched another juvenile causing the victim to temporarily lose consciousness and chipping two of his teeth. On 20 November 2009, the juvenile and another co-juvenile stole a car from Phillipsburg. The co-juvenile drove the car to Somerville. Davis was a passenger. Once in the Somerville area, Davis took over driving the automobile. When the police attempted to stop the car for motor vehicle violations, Davis attempted to elude the police.
