Pay:

\$ 60 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty,

\$ 15 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty;

\$ 120 Restitution to victim for un-reimbursed medical expenses

Provide a DNA sample;

Undergo fingerprinting,

Undergo a mental health evaluation and complete any recommended treatment,

Have no contact with the co-juvenile or victim.

Attend school and obey school rules


Obtain and maintain part time employment,

Circumstances of the offense:

On March 17, 2008, Andrew Figuccio and a co-juvenile, both residents of Mt Bethel., PA waited outside of Belvidere High School for the juvenile victim who was a student at the school. Figuccio and the co-juvenile confronted the juvenile victim when he left the school. Figuccio punched the victim knocking him to the ground. Once the victim was on the ground Figuccio began kicking him in the head. The assault ended when the Belvidere Police arrived at the scene, at which time, Figuccio fled on foot.
