STATE IN THE INTEREST OF BRANDON BRILL & GEORGE NOMIKOS

On August 28, 2007, the Honorable Ann R. Bartlett sentenced a juvenile, Brandon Brill, age 15, to incarceration in the New Jersey Training School for Boys, Jamesburg, for two (2) years on (1) count of eluding, a second degree offense, and one (1) count of theft of a motor vehicle, a third degree offense. The judge also ordered the following:

- (1) Provide a DNA sample,
- (2) Undergo fingerprinting,
- (3) Pay a \$1,000.00 fine,
- (4) Pay a \$60.00 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty,
- (5) Pay a \$15.00 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty,
- (6) 10 year suspension of driver's license,
- (7) Pay restitution to owner of motor vehicle

Brill plead guilty to one (1) count of eluding, a second degree offense and one (1) count of theft of a motor vehicle, a third degree offense. The charges resulted from an investigation by the Greenwich Township, Pohatcong Township, and Washington Township Police Departments which revealed the following: On May 9, 2007, Brill unlawfully took a pickup truck from an Alpha business parking

lot and drove it from Alpha through Greenwich to Washington Township where he crashed the vehicle. Along the way, he drove at high rates of speed and eluded police officers who signaled him to stop.

The matter was handled by John Cornish, Esq., on behalf of the juvenile and Dit Mosco, Assistant Prosecutor, on behalf of the State.

The third degree offense carries a potential maximum sentence of two (2) years, and the second degree offense carries a potential maximum sentence of three (3) years, in the custody of the Juvenile Justice Commission.

On August 28, 2007, the Honorable Ann Bartlett sentenced a juvenile, George Nomikos, 17, to two (2) years probation on one (1) count of possession of Psilocybin, and one (1) count of possession with intent to distribute more than 50 grams of marijuana, both third degree offenses. As conditions of probation, the judge ordered the following:

- (1) 60 days detention in Warren Acres; 20 will be suspended, the juvenile has credit for 38 days already served and must serve 2 additional days,
- (2) Perform 100 hours of community service,
- (3) Provide a DNA sample;
- (4) Undergo fingerprinting,
- (5) Undergo a substance abuse evaluation and complete any recommended treatment,
- (6) Obtain and maintain part time employment when in school,
- (7) Pay a \$60.00 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty,
- (8) Pay a \$2,000.00 Drug Enforcement and Demand Reduction penalty,
- (9) Pay a \$50.00 forensics lab fee,
- (10) Pay a \$15.00 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty,

- (11) Six months delay in obtaining driver's license,
- (12) Letter of apology to parents.


Nomikos plead guilty to one (1) count of possession of psilocybin and one (1) count of possession with intent to distribute more than 50 grams of marijuana, both third degree offenses. The charges resulted from an investigation and search of the juvenile's bedroom by the Oxford Township Police Department on July 22, 2007, at which time the police discovered more than 60 grams of mushrooms containing Psilocybin and more than 50 grams of marijuana. The juvenile stated he intended to sell the marijuana.

These third degree offenses each carry a potential maximum sentence of two (2) years in the custody of the Juvenile Justice Commission.

The matter was handled by John C. Cornish, Esq., on behalf of the juvenile and Dit Mosco, Assistant Prosecutor on behalf of the State.
