#### **STATE IN THE INTEREST OF DAVID A. CHRISTIAN & JUSTIN C. WILLIAMS**

**Address: Phillipsburg, Warren County, New Jersey**

On August 7, 2007, the Honorable Ann R. Bartlett sentenced a juvenile, David A. Christian, age 17, to one (1) year probation on one (1) count of conspiracy to commit burglary, a third degree offense. The judge also ordered the juvenile to:

- (1) Spend 30 days in Warren Acres Juvenile Detention Center; 24 days will be suspended, the remaining six days will be served on two consecutive weekends.
- (2) Perform 45 hours of community service,
- (3) Have no contact with the co-juvenile and co-defendants involved in the incident,
- (4) Pay a \$30.00 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty,
- (5) Pay a \$15.00 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty,
- (6) Provide a DNA sample,
- (7) Undergo fingerprinting,
- (8) Obtain and maintain a full time job
- (9) Write a letter of apology to victim

Christian plead guilty to one (1) count of conspiracy to commit burglary.

The charge resulted from an investigation by the Phillipsburg Police Department which revealed that on August 7, 2007, Christian, another juvenile, and two adult co-defendants conspired to break into and unlawfully remove items from a home

in Phillipsburg. One of the adults planned to enter the residence while the other adult and the two juveniles acted as lookouts.

Charges involving the other participants are pending court.

This third degree offense carries a potential maximum sentence of two (2) years in the State Correctional Facility for Juveniles.

The matter was handled by Harold Bush, Esq., on behalf of the juvenile and Dit Mosco, Assistant Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

On July 31, 2007, the Honorable Ann R. Bartlett sentenced a juvenile, Justin C. Williams, age 13, to one (1) year deferred disposition on one (1) count of criminal mischief, a fourth degree offense. The judge also ordered the juvenile to:

- (1) Tour the Warren Acres Juvenile Detention Center,
- (2) Perform 20 days of community service,
- (3) Pay one fourth of the total restitution for damages,
- (4) Attend school and obey school rules, or
- (5) Write a letter of apology to the victims,
- (6) Pay a \$30.00 Violent Crimes Compensation Board Penalty, and
- (7) Pay a \$15.00 Law Enforcement Officers Training and Education Fund penalty.

Williams plead guilty to one (1) count of fourth degree criminal mischief.

The charge resulted from an investigation by the Phillipsburg Police Department which revealed that on February 3, 2007, Williams and three other juveniles spray painted their initials on several cars and buildings in Phillipsburg.


One co-juvenile previously plead guilty. Charges are pending against the remaining two co-juveniles.

This fourth degree offense carries a potential maximum sentence of one (1) year in the State Correctional Facility for Juveniles.

The matter was handled by Ryan Dornish, Esq., on behalf of the juvenile and Dit Mosco, Assistant Prosecutor on behalf of the State.
