On April 6, 2021, Independence Township Police were called for a report of an altercation at 203 Petersburg Road between Michael Tremblay and a male juvenile. Mr. Tremblay had accused the juvenile of driving unsafely on his driveway while dropping off a friend who resided in a rental apartment on Tremblay's property. Mr. Tremblay confronted the juvenile by driving his vehicle alongside the juvenile's vehicle. The juvenile reported seeing Tremblay with a firearm during this encounter. A search warrant was thereafter obtained for the residence of Mr. and Mrs. Tremblay. search revealed a large quantity of ammunition in various sizes. Neither Mr. nor Mrs. Tremblay were legally eligible to possess ammunition.

On August 11, 2021, Michael Tremblay was charged with the following offenses and lodged in the Warren County Correctional Center pending a detention hearing:

- 1. Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons, Fourth Degree, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7(a)
- 2. Illegal Possession of Ammunition, Fourth Degree, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-3J
- 3. Harassment, a Disorderly Persons Offense, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:33-4(a)

Spring Tremblay was also charged with the following offenses and lodged in the Warren County Correction Center pending a detention hearing:

- 1. Certain Persons Not to Have Weapons, Fourth Degree, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-7(a)
- 2. Illegal Possession of Ammunition, Fourth Degree, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-3J

Fourth Degree offenses carry a maximum sentence of eighteen (18) months in New Jersey State Prison, Disorderly Persons Offenses carry a maximum sentence of 180 days in County Jail.

The defendant is presumed innocent unless and until he is proven guilty
