On November 13, 2023, New Jersey State Police conducted a commercial vehicle inspection on Route 78 in Alpha Borough. The inspection led to a search of the truck that Mr. Young was driving, along with the trailer he was towing. As a result of that search, 179 pounds of marijuana was discovered, along with a loaded handgun and a large capacity magazine. The marijuana seized possesses a street value of over \$250,000.

Young and his passenger, Ms. Davenport, were arrested and charged with the following offenses:

First Degree charges carry a maximum potential sentence of 20 years in New Jersey State Prison. Second Degree charges carry a maximum potential sentence of 10 years in New Jersey State Prison. Fourth Degree crimes carry a maximum potential sentence of 18 months in New Jersey State Prison.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and that the defendants are presumed innocent until and if proven guilty at trial beyond a reasonable doubt.
